PRIOR TO GO-LIVE, IT IS IMPORTANT THE FOLLOWING BE COMPLETED TO ENSURE FAIR AND EQUITABLE ACCESS TO THE IPOS KIDNEY PROGRAM:

- ❖ Provide any information/updates needed by your local IT department to ensure coordination leading to go-live
- ❖ Liaise with your local Transplant Programs to ensure any required coordination needed upon go-live of the IPOS Kidney program has been discussed, including any needed updates to local processes and SOPs
- ❖ Identify and enter into the CTR or via local IT web feeds to the CTR all pediatric patients who will be eligible for the IPOS Kidney program once launched

Note all Pediatric patients regardless of dialysis status or cPRA will be eligible

On completion of go-live activities (i.e., all Canadian Blood Services and provincial platforms are updated to include IPOS Kidney allocation functionality) transplant recipient coordinators are responsible for ensuring all eligible pediatric recipients are listed in the CTR.

We highly recommend liaising with your IT department regarding day of go-live activity.
